

Oenothera - Care Guide

Growing Oenothera

Evening Primrose, Sundrops

The Oenothera which we grow are perfectly hardy forms of Evening Primrose. The two species which we grow have flowers which open during the day and are very short lived. They grow and flower best in full sun in poorish soils and are best divided in the spring although softwood cuttings are also straightforward.

O. fruticosa 'Fireworks' is a popular herbaceous border plant with purple-brown flushed leaves and yellow flowers opening progressively from red buds. This variety will grow 2-3ft in height.
